

PRE-TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. ROSTER REGULATIONS

All rosters must be in accordance with article 502 of the 2009 ASA Code. You must bring Your official ASA Roster (signed by your ASA Commissioner of their designee) Minimum Of one ACE certified coach must be on the field at all times. Coaches must show ACE card when checking in.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Please review 2009 ASA Code Part 5 on Eligibility. We will do individual player check in prior to your first game. We request that you be at the Tournament office one hour and a half before your first game for check in to allow your team enough time for warm up. Individual player check in will start at 8AM on Friday, June 12th.

3. BIRTH CERTIFICATES

Please bring copies of your birth certificates with a photo attached if you do not have photo id with player birth date on it (the copies will not be returned). If your team registers with Register ASA those ID's will be accepted as well for verification.

4. COACHES MEETING/DRAW

We are not holding a Coaches Meeting or Draw in an effort to save everyone as much money as possible. All info that we would discuss at the coaches meeting is listed in this material.

6. GATE ADMISSION

Admissions will be as follows:

Week end pass for Adults*	\$11.00

Daily pass for Youth**	3.00

* Adults 18 years and older

** Youth 13 years old to 18years old

Team passes: we will provide each team with tournament passes for their players, plus three (3) tournament passes for the coaches/managers (three only).

**** ON SITE TOURNAMET INFORMATION****

1. TIME LIMIT

There will be a ONE HOUR AND 40 MINUTES TIME LIMIT. If the game is tied after the time limit has expired, the tie breaker rule shall be in effect at the start of the next inning.

PLEASE NOTE: To help us keep the tournament on schedule we have asked the umpires to strictly enforce the following rules.

ASA RULE 6 SEC 8: At the beginning of each half inning ... no more than one Minute may be used to deliver not more than five pitches.

ASA RULE 7 SEC 3 C: After entering the batter's box, the batter MUST remain in the box with at least one foot between pitches and while taking signals and practice swings.

2. TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE

To determine the order of finish among tied teams we will use the procedure found in the 2009 ASA Code, Article 510 J. 01.c.

1. Head to head competition.
2. The team which advanced the farthest in the winner's bracket.
3. Won-Loss records.
4. Fewest runs allowed per game.
5. Most runs scored per game.
6. If a tie still exists, by a coin toss.

3. LINE UP CARDS

All line-up cards will be provided. Line up cards will be in your participant packet which you can pickup at check in.

4. Balls

Balls will be provided which will be the Dudley Thunder Heat, which will be given out at the coin flip.

5. HOME TEAM

Home teams will be determined by a coin flip with the score keeper for the field which you will be playing on. We request that this be done 30 minutes before the game time. Home will take the first base dugout and visitors will take third base dugout.

6. LINE UPS

Line ups are to be turned in to the score keeper when you do your coin flip.

7. PRE-GAME WARM UPS

Since we will be using all fields, all pre-game warm ups will be conducted by both teams behind the temporary fences on the field where you are scheduled to play the next game. The pitcher's warm up and batting nets are requested to stay between the fields ----- not on the outfield grass.

8. FIELD ETIQUETTE

The Field Maintenance Team will be dressing the field between each game, we request your cooperation in staying off the infield until the field is completely prepped. This is a safety issue, so we appreciate you cooperation. Thank You.
