HALL OF FAME AND HALL OF HONOR NOMINATION PROCEDURES

ARTICLE I - PURPOSE

- 1.01** To honor those persons who have played a major role in the growth and development of Georgia ASA softball.
- 1.02** To help bring to the attention of the Georgia public the wide-spread value of, and interest in, the game of softball by so honoring those who have made outstanding contributions to its success.

ARTICLE II - NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

- 2.01** Hall of Fame
- A. Players Only.
 - B. Must have played a minimum of ten (10) years.
 - C. Will be selected according to the following guidelines:
 - 1. Managers - must have been a manager at least ten (10) years and distinguished themselves through championship play.
 - 2. Umpires - must have been an umpire for at least ten (10) years and distinguished themselves through championship lay.
 - 3. Commissioner - must have been a commissioner for at least ten (10) years and made an outstanding contribution to Georgia ASA.
 - 4. Meritorious Service - will include those individuals or organizations not eligible under another category who have made an outstanding contribution to Georgia ASA. Will include, but not limited to, administrators, organizers, sportswriters, financial contributors, fans, and sponsors.
 - D. No more than ten (10) candidates may be selected to the Hall of Honor in one year.
 - E. No more than three (3) candidates may be selected in any one category.
- 2.03** Nominations must be:
- A. Submitted in writing to the Georgia ASA State Office by the deadline established by the Hall of Fame Committee.
 - B. Nominations should be submitted on the official form provided by Georgia ASA, but should also include a written presentation listing nominee's accomplishments. Presentation may include statistics, honors received, accomplishments, and contributions to Georgia ASA. Printed material such as news clippings, program, or other such items may be included.
 - C. Nominations not selected will be held over for consideration the next year.

ARTICLE III - SELECTION PROCEDURES

- 3.01** The State Commissioner shall appoint a Hall of Fame Committee which must include at least one (1) commissioner, player representative, and umpire.
- 3.02** The Hall of Fame Committee shall meet at least thirty (30) days prior to the Hall of Fame Banquet and make appropriate selections from nominations submitted.
- 3.03** A candidate must receive a majority vote to be selected.
- 3.04** The Hall of Fame Committee may, with just cause, remove an individual or organization elected to the Hall of Fame or Hall of Honor.

ARTICLE IV - AWARDS AND PRESENTATIONS

- 4.01** Those selected for enshrinement will be presented a commemorative plaque and a lifetime pass to all Georgia ASA events.
- 4.02** Those selected will be asked to provide a memento to be permanently exhibited by Georgia ASA.
- 4.03** Formal induction ceremonies and presentation of awards will be made at a banquet the evening prior to the Annual Spring Meeting of Georgia ASA.
